Dear people concerned with the high prices of Xtandi,

I am a prostate cancer patient. I have been taking Xtandi since July 2014.

I am also 68 years old, retired and on Social Security and Medicare with a drug supplement from AARP.

My out of pocket drug costs for 2015 was \$9,769.41. The bulk of this was for Xtandi as the only other prescription drug I take is Metformin which only costs \$2.65 per month.

This expense is daunting, especially as viewed from the fact that I paid taxes to help develop the drug and now have to pay more for the drug than people from other countries just because I get my drug in the US.

My out of pocket cost for drugs for the 1st quarter of 2016 has been \$5,373.62.

I am in favor of putting the Bayh-Dole Act of 1980 into effect. Retro-actively would be preferable.
